

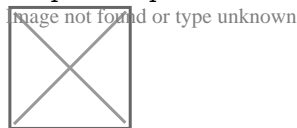

### Description

So how are they different? FastTemplates was originally a Perl library that was ported to PHP. FastTemplates works well for Perl programs, but it's not ideal for PHP. Kristian Koehtopp wrote PHPLIB Template from the ground up as a pure PHP library to better take advantage of the capabilities of PHP. One advantage to Kristian's design is that it parses templates with `preg_replace()`, which is said to be faster than FastTemplate's reliance on `ereg_replace()`. Another advantage of PHPLIB Template is it allows dynamic blocks to be nested, unlike FastTemplates.
